Intervention 1

Vouchers

Cost: £90.00

3 vouchers for achieving ninety stars totalling forty-five pounds, which were rewarded for excellent behaviour. The vouchers work to encourage young people to behave exceptionally well in each lesson throughout the day. There were a total of 3 vouchers awarded to the same student in a bid to further encourage good behaviour, engagement, attitude and effort in lessons. It is believed that by rewarding the young person with JD vouchers and other forms of acknowledgement, this will not only re-enforce positive behaviour but it will give the young person targets to work towards in order to be able to treat themselves to something, they may not otherwise be able to do. This also helps the young person with confidence, self-esteem and praise which are important factors for their well-being and overall education efforts.

Intervention 2

Ilderton Project

Cost: £1,208

The project was attended once a week by the young person, whom had interests and passions associated with mechanics and car engineering. The project offered work experience and training within that particular field. This project worked to benefit the young person in terms of their future goals and career which would not only offer relevant experience and training but also help to give the young person an in-sight into their chosen career and encourage them to further pursue their passions. The emphases of the importance of attendance and punctuality in regards to working life and offer an overall in-sight into post-16. The regular attendance of such a project offers a real-life taster for work life after secondary school and

helped to engage the young person in work, training and personal development. This intervention was put in place to support engaging this young person with education as his attendance prior to this intervention was 17% he was subject to an attendance advisory referral once the intervention was put in place his attendance increased to 23.5%.

Intervention 3

SLA Greenwich Attendance Advisory

Cost: £200

This intervention works to advise the importance of regular attendance to school, not just in terms of a healthy school attendance and therefore improved educational grades but also the importance of attendance and punctuality throughout life, in regards to post-16, college and work. This intervention aims to improve the poor attendance of relevant young people thus creating an awareness of time-keeping and prioritising.

Intervention 4

Family Therapy

Cost: £200

This intervention was put in place you support a student who was transitioning back to mainstream and having sever difficulties at home with parents. 3 sessions of family support were put in place with the school counsellor.

Intervention 5

Laptop

Cost: £260

This intervention was put in place to support the in class learning style of a young person with handwriting difficulties and ADHD.
